

Locomotive Rider Rules

While aboard the locomotive, a cab rider will follow the below rules:

- Do not speak to the locomotive engineer while the train is in motion.
- All provided PPE must be worn at all times (hearing protection can be removed only while the train
 is not in motion)
- The use of cell phones or other electronic devices is strictly prohibited—devices must be turned off and put away—at all times. Photographs can be taken when the train has stopped, but only at the discretion of the conductor or engineer.
- Finger rings cannot be worn regardless of material/type.
- Remain seated at all times while the locomotive is in motion.
- Do not open any cabinet doors or restroom door.
- Do not touch or operate any locomotive controls, radio mic, handbrake handle/wheel brake valves, or switches.
- Do not open or close the windows or doors on the locomotive, unless in an emergency situation.
- Smoking or vaping is strictly prohibited.
- Do not cross the safety chain at any time, unless in an emergency situation. Remain on the conductor side.
- Do not wear open-toed shoes.
- Use of cameras and/or recording devices are strictly prohibited.
- Firearms or other weapons are not permitted.
- Use of foul language or inappropriate or rude behavior at any time will not be tolerated.
- When dismounting the locomotive, step slowly with one foot at a time from the bottom step to the ground, do not jump.
